- Drummer Kenny Suarez's talent on the drums is well known both locally and nationally, and he has toured with many jazz greats.

Levy and his band deliver what all jazz music lovers desire: musical talent with feeling and soul! And they'll be rippin' it up in September at the 4<sup>th</sup> Friday Clearwater event.
